

## Adoption Resolution Board of Directors Resolution # 2021-01 (Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Budget Adoption)

A Resolution of the elected officials of Summit Fire and Medical District adopting an operating budget for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 in the amount of \$7,954,206; to set the Districts Mil Rate to 3.25; to encumber sufficient funds to cover outstanding items (liabilities, purchase orders, invoices etc.) from the previous fiscal year; and to commit any remaining revenues over expenditures to be transferred to the next fiscal year's budget.

Whereas, Arizona Revised Statues, Title 48 require the Summit Fire and Medical District to adopt an annual operating budget and:

Whereas a Public Hearing was held in compliance with State Law on the proposed Fiscal Year 2021-2022 operating budget containing funding for continued emergency and fire services, salaries, wages and benefits for District employees, general operating expenditures, continued training expenditures , and debt services.

Resolved at a duly noticed public meeting of the Governing Board of Summit Fire and Medical District to adopt the Fiscal year 2021-2022 Annual Operating Budget in the amount of \$7,954,206(attached); to encumber sufficient funds to cover outstanding items (liabilities, purchase orders, invoices, etc.) from the previous fiscal year; and to commit any remaining revenue over expenditures to be transferred to the next fiscal year; on Wednesday, June 16, 2021 by a majority of the Governing Board Members.
