# 4. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

The Chairman shall announce this portion of the District Board meeting as a Call to the Public which is for public input/comment. Individuals addressing the Board are typically limited to three minutes for their comments. The Governing Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issues raised during the Public Forum unless they are agendized due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Laws. However individual Board members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Therefore, pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.01(H), action taken as a result of public comment on non-agendized topics will be limited to directing staff to study the matter, responding to any criticism, or scheduling the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date. If warranted, issues raised may be placed on the agenda of a future meeting.
